The following 5 facts are as of mid-January 2024.

1. **There are over 335 million people living in the United States.**

162 million Americans are employed. 139 million people are employed at full and part time

2. **jobs with private sector business. 23 million people are employed at various levels of government.**

3. **Over 30 million working age people are not presently employed. However, they could be available for full or part time jobs as jobs expand in the United States.**

The United States Census reports that more than 43 million Americans of all ages are

4. **living below the federal income poverty guidelines. This statistic will change for the better as more jobs are created in the United States.**

In order to pay off the \$34 trillion dollar national debt which has been generated with the approval of America's national elected leaders over the years, every man, woman and child

5. **in the United States would have to pay the federal government \$101,000 to pay off America's national debt. This is why we continue to encourage a balance budget amendment be enacted for the United States Federal Government.**
